Dear Future MHS Students,

Selecting your schedule for the 2020-21 school year is a responsibility and a privilege. This is an exciting opportunity to take ownership of these choices as you move closer toward graduation and prepare yourself for your college and career goals. Please be attentive to the directions given in the MHS counselors' presentations and then take all the information home to discuss your options with your parents/guardians.

Things to remember when filling out Course Request Sheets:

1. Review the Career and Course Planning Guide for information about specific courses, grade levels offered, and their prerequisites. Do not put any course on your Request Sheet (including in the alternate section) if you do not meet the grade level or prerequisite.
2. List four alternates on your Request Sheet in order of preference. These alternates will be used in case any of your elective choices are full or a particular elective will not fit into your schedule. Failure to list alternates will result in getting whichever courses have spots left after all other schedules are filled; and schedule change requests will not be honored for students who chose not to list alternates.
3. When entering your requests into the computer be sure to select the correct semester if needing a sequence of classes (For example: if you would like to take Woods I and Woods II, you would need to mark Woods I for Semester 1 and Woods II for Semester 2) If there is no prerequisite for a course, leave it marked as any semester for the best results.

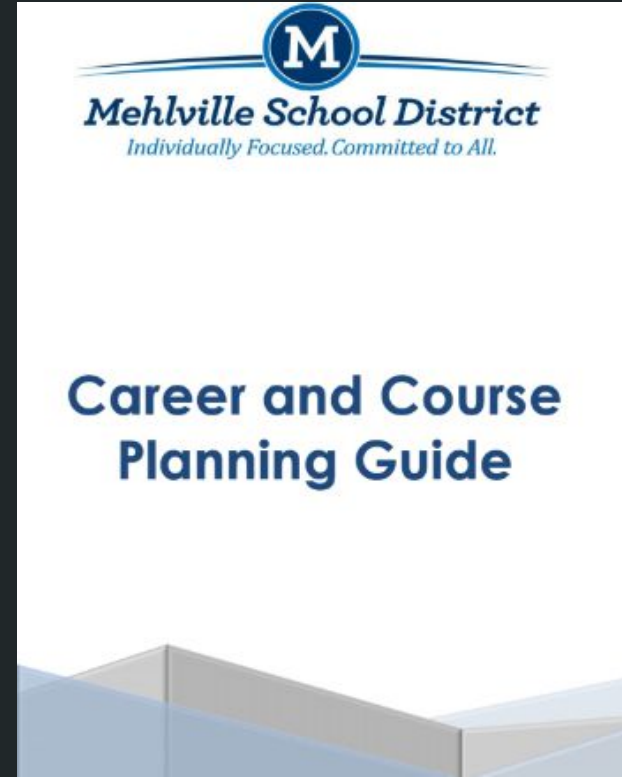

- Use your Missouri Connections account to check into suggested courses in your career path.
- Talk with your teachers about courses they recommend for you in their departments.
- Research the websites of colleges you are interested in attending to see what their entrance requirements are; and make sure you are taking the courses they require.
